Microsoft Xbox 360 Elite (120 GB)

(First Xbox 360 with native HDMI output)

Console

Refurbished by Microsoft twice in response to red-ring-o-death. Now contained "jasper" which finally solved thermal issues (causing solder to soften and create dry joints)

Black

Good condition - chrome still looks nice, small dent in side of unit.

Controller

Poor condition

Works well, but rubber grip surface of left thumb stuck is missing a piece (well loved!). Works fine, but doesn't have the same tactile feel as a whole controller.
